In the year 1982 the counting has been fixed. Furthermore, the word “Ahrenshoop” has been attached to the conference series, although the early conferences in the list below have taken place at other sites. The first truly international meeting took place in 1972 in Heiligendamm with Eugene Cremmer, Gerhard Höhler, Holger Nielsen and David Olive as participants from Western Europa. To a large extent the permission to invite colleagues from the West was positively influenced by the success of a larger international conference organized together with JINR Dubna in Reinhardtsbrunn in the spring of the same year. This inspired our colleagues in 1982 to include this Reinhardtsbrunn conference and a follow-up in 1978 into the counting.
